TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AUGRABIES PV SPECIALIST STUDY

Dear Philip

As requested, please find below the terms of reference that guided the above study:

ACO Associates cc was asked to assess the impacts to heritage resources that might occur through construction of a photo-voltaic solar energy facility on Rooipad 15/9. Two alternative sites are proposed for assessment and the study must include:

- physical inspection of both alternatives;
- consideration of the archaeology, built environment and cultural landscape aspects of heritage documentation of all heritage resources through photography and GPS co-ordinates (palaeontology will be covered by a separate specialist);
- mapping of all documented heritage resources;
- production of a specialist report detailing the findings and assessing the impacts on any identified heritage resources; and
- consultation with the VIA specialist as required.

The study should be carried out in accordance with general best practice for the heritage profession and should be guided by the specialist guideline for involving heritage practitioners in EIA processes as prepared for the Western Cape Province (Winter, S. & Baumann, N. 2005. Guideline for involving heritage specialists in EIA processes: Edition 1. CSIR Report No ENV-S-C 2005 053 E. Republic of South Africa, Provincial Government of the Western Cape, Department of Environmental Affairs & Development Planning, Cape Town.). The report will ultimately be considered by the South African Heritage Resources Agency (for archaeology) and Heritage Northern Cape/Ngwao Boswa Kapa Bokoni (for built environment and landscape impacts).
