
Dear Mr Du Plessis

As discussed telephonically today, notice is hereby given in terms of regulation 15(1) of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, [Government Notice (GN) No. R. 543 as corrected by "Correction Notice 1" (GN No. R. 660 of 30 July 2010) and "Correction Notice 2" (GN No. R. 1159 of 10 December 2010)] promulgated in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) that Mulilo Renewable Energy (Pty) Ltd, intends applying to the national Department of Environmental Affairs for Environmental Authorisation to construct a **10 MegaWatt Photovoltaic Electricity generation plant** and associated infrastructure of up to **19.9 hectares** in area on Portion 9 of Farm 15 Rooipad near Augrabies. The initial proposal was for the transmission line to connect directly to the 22kV adjacent to this property which would then not directly impact your farm.

Nevertheless, Eskom have indicated that they may require that the project connect the 22 kV transmission line a distance of 385 metres to the Blouputs substation which is located on farm 431 (LPI code C03600000000043100000), which is registered as owned by the Burger Du Plessis Familie Trust. I understand that you are a trustee of this trust.

The proposed transmission line would comprise wooden poles up to 8.5 metres high with three wires on top – similar and running parallel to the transmission lines already on your property.

As environmental consultant, I am mandated to communicate only in terms of the environmental (NEMA) process, and if the proposal proceeds, you will be contacted as part of a separate process to negotiate on land rights and financial compensation. Acknowledgement of receipt of this notification does not constitute consent.


